


Fig. 1: OOP FDP Schedule


The program was inaugurated in the presence and with blessings of:


### **WELCOME Ceremony:**

BOS chairman Hon. Dr. S. S. Sane sir shared his views on MCA (2 Years) 2020-21 course. Sir assured that this course will flourish in coming years as duration of this course is reduced from 3 years to 2 years. Sir briefed about the course designing process and focused on inclusion of CO, PO, case studies and project based learning in this new course. He highlighted the importance of OOP subject in this new course. He advised faculty members to use real world examples while teaching the concepts of OOP. Sir also mention that students find difficulties in understanding some OOP concepts like template, virtual function, file handling, etc. so it must be deliver properly to them. Sir has given following suggestions:

- 1. To create bank of laboratory assignments by all faculties from all colleges and share it with students.
- 2. Use of code zinger which will be beneficial for students to improve coding capabilities.
- 3. Use of Virtual Labs AICTE for laboratory assignments.

In the function, Chief Guest Dr. M. U. Kharat sir elaborated the importance of OOP subject in MCA 2 Years course. Sir also shared his views on framing of MCA course. Sir said, this course is designed for students from different educational background similarly it is coped up with industrial advancements and has included all the contents of previous syllabus of 3 years course. Sir explained how all these aspects are considered while framing the new course. Sir suggested faculty members to teach students basic concepts of OOP and give more focus on practical assignments.

### 3. SESSION 1: Object Oriented Programming (Unit 1 & 2)



Prof. G. G. Raut introduced session expert **Dr. Neeta Deshpande**, Associate Professor, GES's RHS COE MS&R, Nashik.


In the first session, resource person Dr. Neeta Deshpande started her discussion with outcome of this FDP and also elaborated different aspects of teaching process to be consider during this pandemic situation. Madam emphasized on the question framing process so that it will reach above the Blooms Taxonomy level 3 to build brighter students' capabilities. She also advised faculty members to explain

objective and outcome of subjects to students.

Dr. Neeta Deshpande madam shared information related reference books like E Balgurusamy and Bjarne Stroustrup and its mapping with unit 1 and unit 2 syllabus. Madam added another dimension of parallel preparation of students for competitive coding by referring different web sites like Hacker rank, Codechef ,Google kickstart etc.. While highlighting importance of OOP, madam explored that source code of various software are written in C++ language; Adobe Photoshop, Google to name few. She further narrated advantages of OOP as it enhances productivity, has good libraries, functions and provides easy troubleshooting.

Madam also shared Virtual Lab links to be used for practical purpose. It helped to make subject fully understand and created interest among participants.

### 4. SESSION 2: Object Oriented Programming (Unit 3,4 & 6)



Screen Shot 7 & 8: Session 2 by Dr. Prashant Yawalkar


### 5. SESSION 3: OOP Laboratory


